Golf greens, surrounds, tees, fairways, bowling greens



MEDAL is a mixture of perennial ryegrass and red fescue, designed for the construction or overseeding of mediumfine and fine turf under high wear pressure.

The main components of the mixture are the ryegrasses; Barolympic and Eventus. Barolympic is the stand-out cultivar ryegrass for summer sports use. It is ranked with a score of 8.7 in Table G4 of BSPB TGS 2021, the highest Mean score in the entire publication, and more than a full point clear of its nearest rival in G4! See Table 1.

Eventus is ranked #2 for Fineness of Leaf in TGS Table L1 and shows very fast recovery and growth rates (ranked #1 in the top 40, Table L1) for a summer sports ryegrass. This enables quick germination, establishment and mid-season repair in areas of high traffic.

Barlineus and Barrisse are both excellent performers, highly ranked in their respective tables in TGS 2020. They both exhibit exceptionally high shoot density and red thread tolerance for their sub-species of red fescue.

How to use it	
Sowing rate:	25-35g per m²
Oversowing rate:	15-25g per m²
Sowing depth:	8-12mm below thatch
Mowing height:	Down to 5mm
