

Material Safety Data Sheet
This data sheet applies to the following products:

MiSport 0515, 0818, 0520, 0820, 0825, 1030, 1040, 1050, 2060, 2080 and 3080

1. Material

Recycled Rubber Granulate.

2. Composition

Granulated rubber in various sizes from the recycling of truck tyres.

3. Hazards

This product is classified as non-hazardous under normal use and handling conditions (see below).

4. Storage and Handling Precautions

Smoking, eating or drinking should be prohibited in areas of storage and use.

Employ good housekeeping standards to minimise the build up of dusts and avoid the possibility of spontaneous combustion.

Avoid inhalation of dusts and prevent the formation of dusts in concentrations above the Flammable, Explosive or Occupational Exposure Limits.

5. Exposure Limits

OEL – Inhalable Dust: 8 hour TWA – 10mg/m²

Respirable Dust: 8 hour TWA – 5 mg/m². Type OES

6. Personal Protection

Provide adequate ventilation and where this is inadequate local forced ventilation or extraction may be necessary. Where this is not possible, suitable respiratory equipment should be worn.

Suitable eye protection should be worn to prevent the ingress of material.

Cotton/synthetic coveralls are normally suitable.

7. First Aid

Eye Contact – Remove contact lenses. Irrigate copiously with clean fresh water for at least 10 minutes.

Skin Contact – Wash thoroughly with soap and water and a proprietary skin cleanser.

Ingestion – If accidentally swallowed seek medical attention.

Inhalation of fines/dust – Remove to fresh air.

If any symptoms persist seek medical attention.

8. Physical/Chemical Properties

Rubber granules with a slight odour.
Immiscible with water.
Stable under recommended storage conditions.
Keep away from oxidising agents and strongly acidic or alkaline materials.
Fire may liberate hazardous decomposition products.

9. Toxicology

No available data for this product.

10. Ecological Information

This product is non-biodegradable. Keep out of watercourses and drains.

11. Accidental Release

Exclude all sources of ignition and ventilate area. Exclude non-essential personnel.
Avoid dry brushing of spilled material as this may cause dust clouds or static build up.

12. Fire Fighting

Extinguish using CO₂ powder, water spray/mist.
Do not allow run-off to enter sewers or watercourses.
Fire will produce dense black smoke containing hazardous combustion products.
Appropriate self-contained breathing apparatus may be required.

13. Disposal

Dispose of residues in accordance with the Environmental Protection Act 1990.

14. Transport

Not regulated.

15. Other Information
